Juan Carlos Andrade Guevara, is a Biologist, graduated from the Universidad Veracruzana, with a specialty in Diagnosis and Environmental Management from the same university, he completed a Master's degree in Policy, Management and Environmental Law from the Anahuac University of Veracruz. For more than 15 years he was head of Projects in the Civil Association Innovation in Science Education (INNOVEC).

His professional experience is linked to teacher training and development of educational materials for teaching science and STEM disciplines in Basic Education. He has taught teacher training courses for Science Teaching in the USA, Latin America, Europe and Asia.

He was a fellow of the Embassy of the United States in Mexico within the International Visitors Program leaders of Education and is part of the Scientific and Pedagogical Committee of the Global Office for Climate Education (OCE, for its acronym in English) and participates in the Network for the Study of Emerging Socio-Scientific Issues (NESST) of the Smithsonian Center for Science Education, based in Washington D.C. and was part of the Advisory Council of the International Dialogue on STEM Education based in Berlin, Germany.

He was a Technical Advisor for the development of the position paper "STEM Vision for Mexico" and is an active member of the Latin American STEM Network.

He currently works as State-wide Coordinator of the Policy for Fundamental Learning in the Undersecretary of Basic Education of the state of Veracruz, which is carried out with the support of Natura Foundation and the UNESCO Office in Mexico.

He is an advisor in the implementation of the project "Training for climate change mitigation and adaptation in basic education schools in Veracruz."
